TOJO OUT AS ARMY STAFF CHIEF!

BRAZILIAN EXPEDITIONARY FORCE ARRIVES MAPLES!

Tokyo radio said tuesday that Premier Hedeki Tojo has vacated his post as chief of the Army General Staff. He will be replaced in that job by General Yessijirob Umezu, former commander-in-chief of Japan's Kwantung army and Ambassador to Japanese-occupied Manchuria.

Tojo retains his post as Bremier and War Minister.

A Brazilian Expeditionary Force arrived in Naples on Sunday, July 16 to participate with the allied armies in joint operation in Italy. Their arrival was made known in a simultaneous announcement at Washington, London, Rio de Janeiro and headquarters of the Mediterranean theater.
